



SOUTH ALABAMA ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE HAS A GREAT OPPORTUNITY FOR HIGH SCHOOL JUNIORS

Each year, South Alabama Electric Cooperative sponsors a group of local high school juniors for an all-expenses-paid trip to visit the state capital in Montgomery and the nation's capital in Washington, D.C. With COVID-19, the 2021 trip has unfortunately been canceled, but SAEC still wants to help students learn more about electric cooperatives and to award scholarships.

All you have to do is complete and return an application. If you are selected, you will get a chance to interview and be selected for a scholarship. Ten students will be selected, with eight receiving a \$1,000 scholarship and two a \$3,000 scholarship. The interviews will take place in February. You will be notified of the specific date after you have been selected. Interviews may be canceled if COVID-19 precautions don't allow for in-person interviews.

2. Tell us why we should choose you to represent South Alabama Electric.
3. Do some research about electric cooperatives and about South Alabama Electric and your senators and representatives. You'll need to know this for the interview.
